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INTRODUCTION

2020 will undoubtedly have been a very difficult year and will remain the year of an unprecedented global crisis: health, financial, economic... all sectors have been affected.

The port of Bejaia like all other ports has suffered the full impact of this crisis that has undeniably affected its traffic. Overall, it has lost 18.20% with a traffic of 15.74 million tons, compared to the previous year.

This decline affected both imports and exports, hence the decrease in the number of vessels processed, from 1,163 in 2019 to 1,028 in 2020, or 135 fewer vessels.

Imports fell by 3%, with a volume of 10.22 million tons. Refined hydrocarbons decreased by -22.3%, while non-hydrocarbon goods recorded a decline of -1%, with a volume, in 2020, of 9.46 million tons, against 9.57 million tons in 2019. Regarding exports, these have shown a significant decline, estimated at -36%, with a volume of 5.51 million tons. The main reason being the global health crisis that has led to a remarkable decline in demand for crude oil. As such, the port of Bejaia has exported only 4.45 million tons in 2020, against 7.80 million tons in 2019, a decrease of -43%. The general goods for export have, however, achieved a record exceeding 1.066 million tons, an increase of +19%.

Container traffic recorded a slight increase of 1.35% with a total of 246,810 TEU handled in 2020, compared to 243,506 TEU in 2019.

Nevertheless, the market share of the port of Bejaia, in terms of traffic excluding hydrocarbons has evolved positively, rising from 21.8% in 2019 to 22.63% in 2020 and 13% in 2019 to 16% in 2020 for container traffic. It occupies the second place in terms of processing containers after the port of Algiers.

It should be noted that the activities have never ceased to operate at the port of Bejaia, even at the height of the health crisis, during the total containment.

In the register of investments that have succeeded and have had a very positive impact on the port of Bejaia, there is the commissioning of Station 25 which has improved the quality of


service to container ships through the project of the docking window system. Its effective operation from May 2020 has given in a very short time, very convincing results.

The opening of the Extra-Port Logistics Zone of IGHIL OUBE-ROUAK from March 1, 2020, also constitutes an added value for the port of Béjaia. On average, about 50 empty containers are returned daily, for a total of 18 000 boxes a year.

In terms of equipment, the port of Bejaia received in 2020 two (02) automatic spreaders with a lifting capacity of 41 tons each, adjustable for containers of 20 and 40 feet, a (01) mini excavator on tracks and a hydro-cleaner truck with a capacity of 6000 liters.

With the pandemic continuing into 2021, the year promises to be difficult. However, despite the announced drop in activity, everything is being done to ensure the port's profitability and performance, to support its customers and satisfy them.

Thus, it was proceeded among other things to the registration of the project on the continuity of the rehabilitation and strengthening of the dock of the Kasbah, project fully funded by the Ministry of Public Works and Transport.


TRAFFIC EVOLUTION

TRAFFIC EVOLUTION IN 2020



In 2020, the overall traffic that passed through the port of Bejaia was established at 15.7 million tons, down 18.20% compared to the year 2019.

The goods excluding hydrocarbons, which represent more than 67% of the port's traffic, totaled more than 10 million tons, up slightly (0.58%) compared to the previous year. Note that in the import, a decline of 3.11% was recorded, caused by the decline of some products such as wood (-12.16%), sugar (-0.30%), soybeans (-23.95%), oil (-7.50%), and iron (-46.05%). STRUCTURE OF GOODS BY PACKAGING METHOD

In 2020, the total volume of bulk liquids, stood at 5.85 million tons, a considerable decline of about 38.24% was recorded, caused by the regression of crude oil exports.

The solid bulk, reached 6.10 million tons in 2020 with a growth rate of 1.41% compared to the previous year. This development is primarily attributable to corn, wheat and barley with a rate of (4.82%), (1.26%) and (1472.93%) respectively. As for bulk sugar, bulk marble, soybeans and bulk clay, they have recorded a decline of (-0.38%) and (-5.61%), (-23.95%) and (-8.74%) respectively.

Regarding the miscellaneous goods, they also recorded an increase of (0.83%), due mainly to the increase of some products such as: chemicals (20.94%), and non-ferrous metals (62.34%).

On the other hand, other products have recorded a significant decline, such as ferrous metals with (-46.05%), wood (-12.16%) and natural fertilizers (-3.60%).


HYDROCARBONS TRAFFIC

The traffic of hydrocarbons, recorded, during the year 2020, a decline of about (-40.66%) compared to the year 2019. Crude oil exports fell by (-40.95%), and refined hydrocarbons inbound by (-22.34%).



OILSEED TRAFFIC

In 2020, imports of oils reached 635,778 tons in regression of (7.5%) compared to the fiscal year 2019. Similarly, exports regressed by (29.45%) with a volume of 9,150 tons.






GRAIN'S TRAFFIC

The traffic of cereals recorded during the year 2020 an increase of (5.44%), with a volume of 4,320 million tons. Soybeans decreased by (-23.66%), while wheat and corn, they recorded an increase of (+1.2%) and (+17.8%) respectively.

Sugar imports recorded a slight decrease from 1,555,530 tons in 2019 to 1,550,165 tons in 2020. On the other hand, exports have experienced a significant increase of (26.51%) compared to the year 2019.




FERROUS METAL TRAFFIC

The traffic of ferrous metals experienced a significant decrease in fiscal 2020 (-46.05%) compared to the year 2019.


The main cause is the satisfaction of national needs by local production.





PASSENGERS TRAFFIC


The passenger shipping sector has been directly affected by the COVID 19 crisis, especially after the closure of sea, air and land borders, throughout 2020



Container traffic in 2020 reached 246,811 TEU, up 1.36%. The total volume of goods containerized is 2.2 million tons, up (+6.11%) compared to the previous year.

RO RO TRAFFIC

With a total volume of 53,995 tons, Ro-Ro traffic decreased by 26.25% in 2020 compared to the previous year. The number of Ro-Ro vessels, has also decreased by 15 vessels (-41.67%).





NAVIGATION MOVEMENT & QUALITY OF SERVICE

NUMBER OF VESSELS AND GROSS TONNAGE

The number of ships handled in 2020 by the port of Bejaia has reached 1,028 ships, 135 ships less than the previous year. Despite this, there is a marked evolution of grain ships and container ships, respectively (+12%) and (+12.66%). Gross tonnage also fell by (-16.27%) at entry, due to the significant drop in the GRT of oil tankers.
